The Lowe Art Museum seeks four Gallery Guide interns during the Fall 2024 semester to lead guided tours for K-12 and University audiences, support academic workshops, and conduct research on artworks and objects from the museum's collection. Gallery Guides are supported by an extensive 4-week period of training, coaching, and in-gallery experiences to hone creative teaching practices that combine museum education methods and art history with their unique interests, personalities, and backgrounds.

Interns earn three college credit hours towards their degree by signing up for a relevant course. Please check with your department for specific requirements. The time commitment is approximately 10 hours per week, totaling 120 hours for the semester.

How To Apply:

- Submit a cover letter and resume or CV to tolaporter@miami.edu by Monday, July 22nd, 2024. Selected candidates will be notified the first week of August.
- Registration for appropriate course must occur before the start of the Fall 2024 semester.
- Interns' first day is the week of August 19th.

How To Write a Strong Cover Letter

- Explain why you are interested in leading tours at the Lowe Art Museum.
- Describe the skills you have that align with this role.
- Include how the internship advances your academic focus and career aspirations.
- Research the Lowe Art Museum and mention relevant points that connect to the internship.
- Proofread your work, and if possible, have another set of eyes review your cover letter and resume to ensure it's error-free.
